Combined line and copyediting for indie authors: MS Word documents

Using Track Changes. The edit includes a single pass unless otherwise agreed.

This is my most popular service: it combines a light line edit with copyediting.

Line editing for indie authors: MS Word documents

Using Track Changes. The edit includes a single pass unless otherwise agreed.

This is heavy line editing for a text with no structural issues. It can verge on rewriting. The edits include extensive educational feedback. This service does not prepare a text for publication in the same way that a copyedit does. It suits authors who want detailed feedback on a chapter or sample.
